SCHEDULE “SL” SECURITY LIGHT SERVICE

AVAILABILITY:

Available throughout the Cooperative's service territory subject to the established Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative.

DEFINITION:

Dusk to dawn outdoor lighting, other than street lighting for towns and villages.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Mercury Vapor Lamp - 175 Watt - 7,200 Lumen
High Pressure Sodium Lamp – 100 Watt - 8,500 Lumen
High Pressure Sodium Lamp - 150 Watt - 14,400 Lumen
High Pressure Sodium Lamp - 250 Watt - 24,700 Lumen
High Pressure Sodium Lamp - 400 Watt - 44,000 Lumen

Rate Per Light:

7,200 Lumen Mercury Vapor Lamp @ \$9.35 monthly
8,500 Lumen High Pressure Sodium @ \$8.00 monthly
14,400 Lumen High Pressure Sodium @ \$13.75 monthly
24,700 Lumen High Pressure Sodium @ \$19.75 monthly
44,000 Lumen High Pressure Sodium @ \$28.50 monthly

UTILITY TAX:

All charges made under this schedule for electric energy are subject to the prevailing Illinois Public Utility Revenue Tax.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

The Cooperative shall furnish, install, operate and maintain the outdoor lighting equipment including lamp, luminaire, bracket attachment and control device on an existing pole of the Cooperative, electrically connected so that the power for the operation of the light does not pass through the meter for the member's other usage. If an additional pole is required, member will pay for necessary extension of service to a location mutually agreed upon.

The Cooperative shall maintain the lighting equipment, including lamp replacement, at no additional cost to the member within a reasonable length of time after the member notifies the Cooperative of the need for maintenance of the lighting equipment.

The lighting equipment, connecting wires, poles, and appurtenances shall remain the property of the Cooperative. The member shall protect the lighting equipment from deliberate damage.



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The member shall allow authorized representatives of the Cooperative to enter upon the Member's premises as is necessary for maintenance of the lighting equipment and for removal of the Cooperative's properties upon termination of service under this Schedule.

WHOLESALE TRACKER FACTOR

The Cooperative may apply the Wholesale Tracker Factor to recover changes in wholesale power cost in accordance with Schedule WTF.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Electric bills are due and payable when presented. Payment should be made within ten (10) days. If payment is not received within twenty-one (21) days after the date of the original bill, a "Last Reminder" will be sent for which one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) on the unpaid balance or a minimum of \$1.00 will be added to the Account. If payment is not received by the Cooperative before the Collection date shown on the "Last Reminder" the Collection Policy for overdue accounts will be in effect.
